## Submission to the Commerce Commission on the Open letter on Fibre Input Methodologies Review

Electricity Networks Aotearoa (ENA) appreciates the opportunity to make a submission to the Commerce Commission (Commission) on the consultation paper on the *Open letter on Fibre Input Methodologies Review* (open letter).

ENA is the industry membership body that represents the 29 electricity distribution businesses (EDBs) that take power from the national grid and deliver it to homes and businesses (our members are listed in Appendix A).

EDBs employ over 7,800 people, deliver energy to more than two million homes and businesses, and have spent or invested \$6.2 billion in network assets over the last five years. ENA harnesses members' collective expertise to promote safe, reliable, and affordable power for our members' customers.

## WACC review

This submission is focused on the Commission's proposal to review the methodology for the weighted average cost of capital (WACC) across both Part 4 and Part 6.

ENA does not have anything new to add in relation to WACC at this stage. However, DPP4 reset impacts have highlighted how the current methodology doesn't deliver good outcomes for customers and can result in shocks. Alternative methodologies, such as a trailing average, can improve outcomes for customers.

We encourage the Commission to include views raised in previous recent submissions on WACC, including discussions of alternative methodologies, as part of this review. We particularly refer the Commission to the following:
